We will only do this if it is appropriate for you and our business. We will always make sure you have access to this privacy statement.

We are obliged to keep your data up-to-date and may contact you to confirm your current details.

You have a right to withdraw your consent to our use of your personal data. If you have any concerns about the way we handle your personal data you have the right to contact the Information Commissioner (<a href="www.ico.org.uk">www.ico.org.uk</a>) or if you have a concern our Company has a complaints handling procedure.

### 2 Disclosure of Data to Third Parties

We will only disclose your personal data as instructed. For example, where we submit a planning application on your behalf, your details will form part of the planning application and be publicly available via the Local Planning Authority.

We may disclose information about you to any of our employees, consultants, and others engaged on a project on your behalf, insofar as it is reasonably necessary within the terms of this Privacy Statement. We may also disclose information as required by law or legal proceedings.

Any disclosure of data will accord with the General Data Protection Regulations.
